I 2. halvår 2021 blev der doneret medicin og hospitalsudstyr for 19.446.208 kr. Siden stiftelsen i 2010 er der i alt doneret for 267.389.181 kr.

**Somalia:** 3 containere hospitalsudstyr, 1 sending medicin, til Sundhedsministerium

**Burundi:** 1 container hospitalsudstyr, til religiøs organisation

**Albanien:** 1 lastbil hospitalsudstyr, til religiøs organisation

**Kenya:** 2 sendinger medicin, 18 paler, til privat organisation

#### ØKONOMI:

Økonomien er for indefærende tilfredsstilende på trods af de betydelige antal donationer og den deraf følgende stigning i fragt- og afhentningsudgifterne, da indtægterne også er steget, mens besparelserne er fastholdt, og der ikke er foretaget nogle kontrolrejser.

Det forventes, at fragtudgifterne fortsat vil stige som følge af en større mængde forsendelser, især medicin med fly, ligesom det vil være nødvendigt at foretage kontrolrejser i 2022. Selvom indtægterne kan fastholdes, vil økonomien utvivlsomt blive presset som følge af den forventede stigning i aktiviteterne og dermed højere variable omkostninger, især fragtudgifterne.

## VÆSENTLIGE BEGIVENHEDER:

Til trods for de relativt mange forsendelser er lageret stadig fyldt med udstyr, sygeplejeartikler og hospitalsmaskiner, hvilket selvfølgelig skyldes, at GMA har fået mange og store donationer. Disse kommer ikke blot fra vore trofaste "leverandører" som Mediq Danmark, men også fra firmaer i andre brancher end decideret hospitalsbranchen som COOP, som har doneret 263.000 stk. visirer på 111 paller, der fyldte 4 store lastbiler.

Lageret er nu blevet bragt i orden og lagerfortegnelse opdateres efter behov. Herefter kan fortægelsen tilsendes de lande, der ønsker udstyr, ligesom overblikket over lagerbeholdningen (også i relation til udløbstid), bevares, og pakningen af containerne sker mere rationelt.

Der er indledt samarbejde med et stort dansk medicinalfirma, som allerede har doneret værdifuld medicin med en udløbstid på 9 – 15 måneder, der fyldte mere end en 20 fods container. Det forventes, at lignende donationer vil ske to gange om året. Den første mængde er allerede givet til GMA og herfra videregivet til Kenya.

Ydermere har to store medicinalfirmaer i England tilbuddt samarbejde, og 17 paller antibiotika er allerede afsendt fra England til Kenya. Fragten skete som sædvanligt med fly og kostede mere end 75.000 kr.

Hjemmesiden er nu (omsider) blevet bragt på plads, om end småjusteringer stadig mangler.

Så snart som det er forsvarligt, vil der blive foretaget rejser til nogle modtagerlande - dels for besigtigelse, men også for at drøfte de visse steder ret restriktive bestemmelser vedrørende modtagelse af medicin og udstyr tæt på udløb.

Det forventes, at der i første halvår af 2022 vil blive indledt samarbejde med 1 – 2 nye lande i Afrika.

## Increased donations (especially of medicines) Large inventory      Increasing shipping costs

**In 2nd half of 2021, medicine and hospital equipment were donated for DKK 19.446.208 .  
Since the foundation in 2010, a total of DKK 267.389.181 has been donated.**

### **MEDICINE AND HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT 2ND HALF OF 2021**

- Somalia:** 3 containers of hospital equipment, 1 shipment of medicine, to Ministry of Health
- Burundi:** 1 container hospital equipment, for religious organization
- Ghana:** 1 container hospital equipment, for religious organization
- Albania:** 1 truck hospital equipment, for religious organization
- Kenya:** 2 consignments of medicine, 18 pallets, for private organization

### **FINANCES:**

The economy is currently satisfactory despite the significant number of donations and the consequent increase in freight and collection costs, as the income has also increased, while the savings have been maintained and no control trips have been made.

It is expected that freight costs will continue to increase due to a larger volume of shipments, especially medicines by plane, just as it will be necessary to make control trips in 2022. Although revenues can be maintained, the economy will undoubtedly be pressured due to the expected increase in activities and thus higher variable costs, especially freight costs.



## **NOTEWORTHY EVENTS:**

Despite these relatively many shipments, the warehouse is still filled with equipment, nursing supplies and hospital machines, which is of course due to the fact that GMA has received many and large donations. These come not only from our faithful "suppliers" like MediQ Denmark, but also from companies in industries other than the hospital industry like COOP, which has donated 263,000 visors on 111 pallets that filled 4 large trucks.

The warehouse has now been put in order and the inventory is updated as needed. This allows the list to be sent to the countries that want equipment, just as the overview of the stock (also in relation to expiration time) is maintained, and the packing of the containers is faster and easier.

A collaboration has been initiated with a large Danish pharmaceutical company, which has already donated valuable medicine with an expiration time of 9 - 15 months, which filled more than a 20-foot container. It is expected that similar donations will be made twice a year. The first quantity has been given to the GMA and from there passed on to Kenya.

Furthermore, two major pharmaceutical companies in the UK have offered collaboration and 17 pallets of antibiotics have already been shipped from the UK to Kenya. The freight took place as usual by plane and cost more than DKK 75,000.

The website has now (finally) been put in place, although minor tweaks are still missing.

As soon as it is sound, travel will be made to some recipient countries - partly for inspection, but also to discuss the rather restrictive regulations in certain places regarding the receipt of medicines and equipment close to expiration.

It is expected that in the first half of 2022, cooperation will be initiated with 1-2 new countries in Africa.
